





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IV. Performance Measures and Reporting Requirements

• Updated Performance Measures and Reporting Requirements to:

- a. Improve the timeliness of prenatal care (initiation of care prior to 14 weeks gestation).
- b. Increase the percentage of maternal health patients who are screened for perinatal mood disorders during pregnancy.
- c. Increase the percentage of maternal health patients who are screened for substance use.
- d. Increase the percentage of maternal health patients who receive a postpartum visit within the first 42 days post-delivery
- The measures were changed to include measures that can be tracked using CPT codes reported in the Local Health Department – Health Services Analysis (LHD-HSA).
